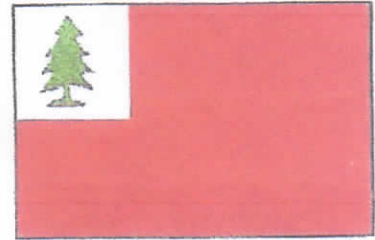
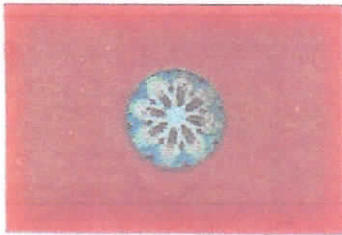

Private-Living Treaty Memorandum of Understanding Non-Disclosure & Non-Circumvention

July 16, 2016

"Eachta Eacha Na", The Honorable: Premier-Principal Chief of Chiefs-Joseph of Joseph: The Mighty and Wise One for the Chigarau Nations of "Turtle Island" and; "Willenewah", the "Great Eagle" of the Aniyvwiya- Kiyowia Sgadugi- Aginsia Anehi-The Rackley Tribe and Chickamauga Nation and; "Chief Greywolf" Principal Chief of the Sovereign Cherokee Nation Tejas in Texas and all Consuls, Governors, Generals and Gerardo Aguilar Rodriguez of the Quiche Maya:

The Parties have concluded the present living working documents of the Private-Living Treaty MOU, NCND are as follows:

Whereas, the parties mutually respect, honor, and accept the General Terms and Definitions as set out by the Private-Living Treaty, MOU with its latest working Annexes and Addendums having the following terminology fully understood and accepted.

EXECUTION DATE: The Signature and Seal Date on which the newly formed Private-Living Treaty Parties receive their respective original copies of this agreement or may be indicated otherwise in this Private-Living Treaty, MOU.

WHEREAS, the Parties mutually desire to create, develop, execute Sovereign to Sovereign relationships under this Private-Living Treaty which shall be for the benefit of all the Parties, successors, and assigns, in accordance with the Universal International jurisdictional laws applicable to the development and the success of all Parties of the negotiated and fully executed Private-Living Treaty with terms and provisions hereunder agreed upon.

Mission Summary

This is a summary of various projects concerning sustainability, humanitarian development, employment, and community needs of the Peoples. The following projects and technologies have been developed and created with an end in mind: A cleaner, greener bio-environment, with advanced societal structure, and state of the art technologies to launch the population successfully into a Better World with the full approval of the tribal Government(s), Local Communities, and the Regional Indigenous Peoples. We have utilized official studies exploring the methods intended to improve the living and educational standards for the populations of each region, with an emphasis on providing new and varied employment to all peoples. Other unofficial studies have been included in this summary which will require a paradigm shift for many communities around the world. We will also use proven models from nations that are of similar geographic, demographic, and climatic parameters for each eclectic microcosm and macrocosm.

Mission Statement

We will develop The Grand Council of Indigenous People's Projects in several social economic Zones for and on behalf of all the peoples; by developing, creating, and building a self-sufficient and sustainable green habitat, including housing that is structurally sound, energy efficient, and affordable, and new technologies for providing fresh water and clean sanitation and energy, as well as education, agriculture, and more available health care.

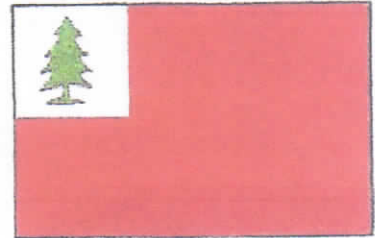
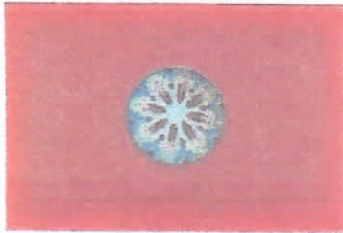
Vision Statement

We will provide the people an opportunity to Thrive by creating, and providing a state of the art, affordable, and sustainable environment with domiciles in communities that have modern day convenient amenities. We will improve the people's basic education of the environment with new technologies developed for reading and language, mentoring programs, hands on

experiences in the model community, thereby enhancing employment skills and providing more accessible health care. We will teach all who are willing to learn, how to fish in the cycle of life.

Instances of philanthropy commonly overlap with instances of charity, though not all charity is philanthropy, or vice versa. The difference commonly cited is that charity relieves the pains of social problems at their root causes (the difference between giving a hungry man a fish and teaching him how to fish for himself).

To Thrive, there are Eight Pillars of human benefits for well-being, through ecological, economic, political, social dimensions, and sustainability.



- Ensure environmental sustainability of mother earth
- Eradicate extreme poverty and hunger
- Achieve universal primary education
- Promote gender equality
- Reduce child mortality
- Improve health and wellness
- Combat HIV/AIDS, malaria, and other diseases
- Develop economic partnerships for infrastructure, community development, natural resources.

CLAUSE 1 – SCOPE of Signing and Sealing Private-Living Treaty: “Eachta Eacha Na”, The Honorable: Premier-Principal Chief of Chiefs-Joseph of Joseph: The Mighty and Wise One, as principal/trustee for: GRAND COUNCIL-CENTRAL BANK-TRUST, AND A CENTRAL BANK for the Peoples of “TURTLE ISLAND” AMERICA’S (TBA) and The Honorable: Chief Greywolf Principal Chief: Sovereign Cherokee Nations Tejas, as principal/trustee for: GRAND COUNCIL-CENTRAL BANK-TRUST, AND A CENTRAL BANK for the Peoples of “TURTLE ISLAND” AMERICA’S (TBA). The Central Banks shall be the fiduciaries, under full corporate authority and responsibility respectively with their representatives for the Private-Living Treaty Parties. The Parties will be the lawful signatories and have the right to take the Reposits of Assets or other Cash Deposits, as hereunder specified for the purposes outlined in the final documents, to be developed, for the betterment of all peoples in the Grand Council.

CLAUSE 2 - GRAND COUNCIL-CENTRAL BANK-TRUST, AND A CENTRAL BANK for the Peoples of “TURTLE ISLAND” AMERICA’S (TBA) will be established. By invitation of the Grand Council of Turtle Island an Introductory Letter of Invitation will be given to acquire a private bank within Turtle Island North America as per Annexes and Addendums herewith attached as an integral part of this Private-Living Treaty MOU. Master Securities Account within the Central Banks and Top Banks, shall be established for the benefit of all peoples of the “Indigenous Nations” of Turtle Island’s Peoples and Tribes.

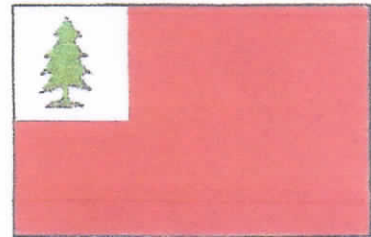
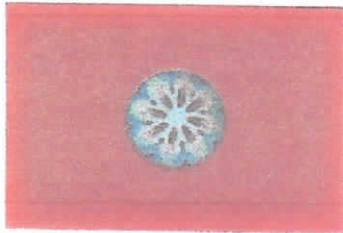
CLAUSE 3 – “Grand Council” Ministry of Diplomatic and Consular Services and International Tribunal Court: Shall be established.

CLAUSE 3.1 – “Grand Council” Ministry of Diplomatic and Consular Services for the “Grand Council” Peoples of “TURTLE ISLAND”. Under this leadership umbrella, we have determined to be and remain a united people, by casting aside all enmity, hatred, malice, and bickering and by recognizing the blood brotherhood of all people under One God.

CLAUSE 3.2 - Ministry-Focus Areas:

We will focus on the complete eco-system enabling the population, as well as the indigenous, to gain economic benefit from the available resources.

6 Focus Areas:

Affordable Housing
Agriculture
Clean Drinking Water
Education
Health Care
Renewable and Green Energy-Carbon Credits

CLAUSE 4 - TIME PERIOD

CLAUSE 4.1 - The ending duration of this Private-Living Treaty MOU shall be in perpetuity until both Parties agree and are noticed properly.

CLAUSE 4.2 - The commencement time for this Private-Living Treaty MOU shall from the date on which GRAND COUNCIL-CENTRAL BANK-TRUST, AND A CENTRAL BANK for the Peoples of "TURTLE ISLAND" AMERICA'S (TBA) and its members execute this memorandum of understanding.

CLAUSE 4.3 - The extension time period of the Private-Living Treaty by and between "Eachta Eacha Na", The Honorable: Premier-Principal Chief of Chiefs-Joseph of Joseph: The Mighty and Wise One for the Chigarau Nations of "Turtle Island" and; "Willenawah", the "Great Eagle" of the Aniyvwiya- Kiyowia Sgadugi- Aginsia Anehi-The Rackley Tribe and Chickamauga Nation and; "Chief Greywolf" Principal Chief of the Sovereign Cherokee Nation Tejas in Texas and their Consuls, Governors, Generals and Gerardo Aguilar Rodriguez of the Quiche Maya upon Turtle Island "Americas": all shall be by mutual agreement, if the extension is duly acknowledged in writing by all Parties.

CLAUSE 5 - INITIAL FUNDS: Once full approval has been received from the proper regulatory authorities for the structuring of accounts within the system for GRAND COUNCIL-CENTRAL BANK-TRUST, AND A CENTRAL BANK for the Peoples of "TURTLE ISLAND" AMERICA'S (TBA) and its members, have vetted funds and said funds will be deposited into the said system, thereby supplying the financial needs of the prospective humanitarian and infrastructure projects. No funds will be allocated to propagate war, or for non-peaceful activities. Only funds for security, common defense, and social and economic world development will be approved.

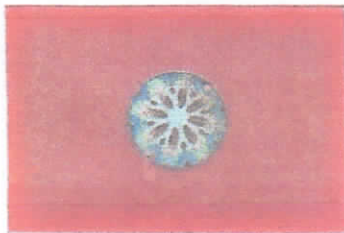
CLAUSE 6 - PAYMENTS AND DISTRIBUTION: The payments and distribution of funds will be in various currencies or other Reserve Currencies mutually agreed upon by the Parties and made by transfer into the New Trust Accounts set up by the GRAND COUNCIL-CENTRAL BANK-TRUST, AND A CENTRAL BANK for the Peoples of "TURTLE ISLAND" AMERICA'S (TBA). Distribution of the funds will follow the bylaws and procedures set forth by GRAND COUNCIL-CENTRAL BANK-TRUST, AND A CENTRAL BANK for the Peoples of "TURTLE ISLAND" AMERICA'S (TBA) agreements. Accounts will be used to distribute start-up capital and the capitalization of the New Reserves for the Central Bank, the Private Indigenous Development Banks, and other programs and projects.

CLAUSE 7 - DEPOSITS AND REPOSITORY RECEIPTS: All DEPOSITS AND REPOSITORY RECEIPTS resulting from "The Humanitarian Projects" and GRAND COUNCIL-CENTRAL BANK-TRUST, AND A CENTRAL BANK for the Peoples of "TURTLE ISLAND" AMERICA'S (TBA), all efforts, contributions, grants, and investment programs will be divided as set forth by the Parties. There will be an "open book accounting" policy from the beginning to end of each program and accountability and

oversight committees both internal and external. Any deposit shall be deposited in the general and regional central bank repository of jurisdiction and all funds will be transferred immediately upon acceptance of the agreements held in private escrow accounts.

CLAUSE 8 – HISTORICAL DOCUMENTS

CLAUSE 8.1 - All emails will be Carbon Copied to all Parties; conference calls will be on secured line conferencing with archive and retrieval available to the Parties. Flow-sheets, Schematics, and Process Flow Diagrams, Business plans, and contacts will be shared upon request weekly.

CLAUSE 8.2 - A master paymaster certification will be issued certifying that all compliance issues have been addressed by the regulatory body.

CLAUSE 9 – DELIVERY: Both Parties will insure that prompt, accurate, and legible documents are delivered. T1 and T2 Capital, Instruments, and cash will be deposited in a timely manner to insure the success and profitability of this Private-Living Treaty MOU. Both Parties will receive and accept the copies of the said agreement along with the approved transactions.

CLAUSE 10 – INSPECTION DETERMINATION: "Eachta Eacha Na", The Honorable: Premier-Principal Chief of Chiefs-Joseph of Joseph: The Mighty and Wise One for the Chigaran Nations of "Turtle Island" and; " Willenewah", the "Great Eagle" of the Aniyvwiya- Kiyowia Sgadugi- Aginsia Anehi-The Rackley Tribe and Chickamauga Nation and; "Chief Greywolf" Principal Chief of the Sovereign Cherokee Nation Tejas in Texas and their Consuls, Governors, Generals and Gerardo Aguilar Rodriguez of the Quiche Maya of Turtle Island "Americas": mutually agree to recognize each other internationally in their sovereign and private capacities, as well as their corporate responsibilities, since both shall be appointed to act as agent and signatory regarding the trust.

CLAUSE 11 – SPECIAL CONDITIONS-CONSIDERATIONS-CONCESSIONS: The Parties hereby mutually warrant that they have exerted and shall continue to exert their best efforts to avoid any action that might be in any manner detrimental to the other Party's interest in the negotiation, execution, and performance of this Contract.

CLAUSE 12 – This Agreement contains the entire understanding between the Parties with respect to the transactions contemplated hereby and can only be amended by written agreement. Any prior assignment, whether written or oral, shall be deemed to be merged herein and shall be suspended by this Agreement.

CLAUSE 12.1 - The articles and other headings in this Private-Living Treaty are for convenience only and shall not be interpreted in any way to limit or change the subject matter of this MOU.

CLAUSE 12.2 - All signed Annexes and Addendums shall constitute an integral part of this working Private-Living Treaty MOU.

CLAUSE 12.3 - EDT (Electronic Document Transmission) shall be deemed valid and enforceable in respect of the provisions of this Contract. Either Party shall be in a position to request a hard copy of any previous electronically transmitted document. Grammatical mistakes or typing errors, if any, shall not be regarded as contradictions.

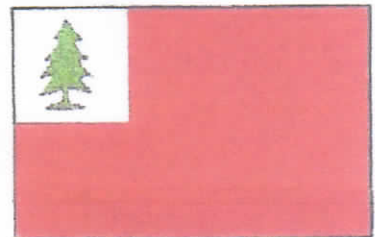
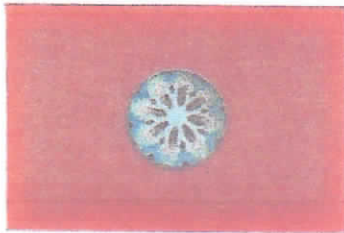
CLAUSE 12.5 - Any information contained herein shall be kept confidential and shall not be reproduced in any way or disclosed to any third party, except one deemed necessary, by both Parties, to the implementation of this Private-Living Treaty MOU.

CLAUSE 13 – CONCLUSION: This Private-Living Treaty MOU consists of Annexes and Addendums. Each Party will retain two (2) copies of this agreement, until the exchange of the original agreement can be signed in person. The Parties agree that the signed stamped copies of this Private-Living Treaty MOU will be in full force and effect until that time. Parties hereby confirm and accept as an original, the MOU sent by facsimile, scanned E-mail, or electronically transmitted.


