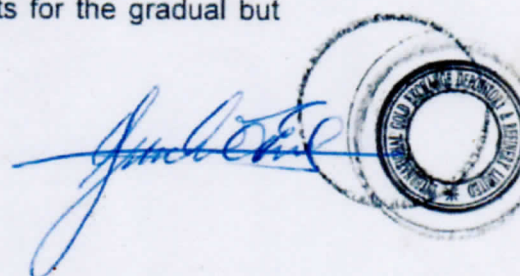

1. The distribution of wealth in accordance with the International Treaties surrounding the Historical Assets and the Disbursement of Funds in accordance with the decision of the World Courts;
2. The provision of Free Educational Opportunities for people around the world;
3. The provision of Employment Training and Employment Opportunities for all people;
4. The provision of safe and secure housing for people around the globe;
5. The provision of Emergency and Non-Emergency Medical Facilities around the globe for the purpose of creating and maintaining a minimum set of health-care standards, and for the provision of free medical care to all people alike;

10. The establishment of global debt relief facilities, bullion banks, vaults and other facilities on a global scale. This will allow for an adequate management of currencies and prevent the erratic inflationary and deflationary periods that cause the destabilization of economies and financial markets in the current system;
11. The establishment of security personnel which is imperative to be able to provide for the physical, structural, electronic and other concerns;
12. The implementation of a global debt forgiveness plan, global debt relief facilities, and a more equitable distribution of wealth to all citizens of the world. ***Organizational Structure***

Under GIDIFA are the GLOBAL TREASURY SUPREME TRUST (GTST), established as the new global clearing and exchange bank, and the GLOBAL INTELLIGENCE BUREAU (GIB) with inherent global diplomatic immunity to allow them to protect the world against economic terrorism and financial crimes globally, and to provide for policing and security for GIDIFA, GTST, and all its other member-organizations.

Pursuant to its charter, GIDIFA is mandated to implement infrastructure and development projects globally. It is projected that such a course of action will provide for the ultimate eradication of poverty and a better quality of life for all people, not merely for any individual class of people.

**The Sovereign Royal Portfolio**

GIDIFA wishes to announce to the world that the Sovereign Royal Portfolio does not only exist, but also contains a cash equivalent (in an "Infinite Account") of 69 digits (in US dollars) known as "duovigintillion". This account is based on and backed up by thirteen million and four hundred and thirteen thousand and five hundred (13,413,500) metric tonnes of gold, excluding precious metals, gems and other assets.

This fact was confirmed twice, once in a [2007 World Bank Document](#) and again in a [2012 World Bank document](#), and further verified by the signatures of over 400 world leaders in the respective World Bank documents. This is in sharp contrast to the information reported by both Wikipedia and the BBC News on April 1, 2013 that the Global Gold Reserve is only one hundred and seventy-one thousand and three hundred (171,300) metric tonnes of Gold.

The Financial World bases its monetary calculations on the Basel Standards, i.e. Basel 3 and Basel 4, such that every dollar in circulation must be gold-backed. Utilizing rudimentary mathematics, the results are as follows:

1. The price of gold per metric ton is approximately forty-two million and five hundred fifty-three thousand and fifty-six US dollars (US \$42,553,056.00). Thus, one hundred and seventy one thousand and three hundred (171,300) metric tonnes of gold results in a total sum in the amount of seven trillion and two hundred and eighty-nine billion and three hundred and thirty eight billion and four hundred and ninety-two thousand and eight hundred US dollars (US \$7,289,338,492,800.00);
2. The 2007 Committee of 300 documents state that the thirteen million and four hundred and thirteen thousand and five hundred (13,413,500) metric tonnes of gold backing the Infinite Account is equivalent to five hundred and seventy trillion and six hundred and fifty-six billion and seven hundred and seventy-six million and six hundred and eighty-six thousand US dollars (US \$570,656,776,686,000);
3. The US Treasury in 2011 issued International Bills of Exchange (IBOE) against the Honorable Angel Ferdinand Marcos' gold deposits that are registered on the Grey Screen, thus confirming him as **M-1**, having the sole control and absolute authority over the SRP or Sovereign Royal Portfolio.

### The Challenge

One of the greatest challenges that needs to be addressed is the concept of the "scarcity" model as a functional monetary and profit bearing system of the financial world versus the "abundance" model.

GIDIFA recognizes the reality that the current economic and financial systems need to be augmented and supported to be stabilized. Hence, the need for a cooperative alliance to be able to work alongside global entities like the United Nations and its member states. This approach utilizes both the *"Build, Operate, and Transfer" (BOT)* model and a *"Build Own and Operate" (BOO)* model for infrastructure and development.

To assure transparency and accountability, GIDIFA, the UN and its member states, have a shared responsibility and obligation to join forces in a cooperative and strategic alliance. Together, utilizing the SRP, it is possible to empower all the people of the world and to lift them out of miserable poverty.

The time has come to work together to ensure that all of humanity can truly enjoy genuine social and economic freedoms. Again, there is an abundance of wealth and resources in the world. We must make certain that this abundance of resources is equitably distributed and available for all humankind.

**Proposition**

GIDIFA wishes to enter into a sovereign treaty with the United Nations and its member states for purposes, including, but not limited to:

1. Structuring a financial strategy in order to discharge up to 100% of every Nation's Debt and other selected obligations, and curbing corruption, thereby strengthening their protection against any potential risk of default within the global economic community by implementing a Global Debt Forgiveness and Financing program and facilitating the equitable distribution of wealth among all people of the world;
2. Underwriting and financing up to 100% of the Master Plan Projects for the UN and its Member Nations, and related initiatives;
3. Underwriting and financing up to 100% of the 2030 UN Millennium Development Goals;
4. Underwriting and financing up to 100% of the Kyoto Protocols; and
5. Underwriting and financing up to 100% of the protocols and standards as set forth in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities.

At the 1944 Bretton Woods Conference, then US Army General George C. Marshall, introduced the "Marshall Plan" to rebuild the affected nations after WWII, largely through the following organizations:

1. The League of Nations, which became the United Nations; and
2. The International Monetary Fund (IMF) and the World Bank Group created to oversee the use of the funds pledged and allocated under the Marshall Plan-underwritten and financed by the SRP.

The common tie that bound the above-mentioned organizations was the establishment of the United States (US) dollar as the world currency, backed, underwritten and financed by the SRP. Following are some of the relevant citations from the websites of the actual organizations in their own words:

"The 44 countries at that conference sought to build a framework for economic cooperation to avoid a repetition of the competitive devaluations that had contributed to the Great Depression of the 1930s. The IMF is an organization of 188 countries, working to foster global monetary cooperation, secure financial stability, facilitate international trade, promote high employment and sustainable economic growth, and reduce poverty around the world. Created in 1945, the IMF is governed by and accountable to the 188 countries that make up its near-global membership."

"The World Bank Group's overarching goal of fighting global poverty through high-quality Bank advice, projects and programs, efficiently delivered to client countries, and to this end we also seek high standards of governance in the Bank. We promote the interests of our constituency by ensuring that its voice is heard in the Bank's decision-making, that resources are allocated fairly on the basis of policy performance, and that the Bank Group continues to improve its performance among the developing member countries..."

3. United Nations:

"Due to the powers vested in its Charter and its unique international character, the United Nations can take action on the issues confronting humanity in the 21st century, such as peace and security, climate change, sustainable development, human rights, disarmament, terrorism, humanitarian and health emergencies, gender equality, governance, food production, and more. The UN also provides a forum for its members to express their views in the General Assembly, the Security Council, the Economic and Social Council, and other bodies and committees. By enabling dialogue between its members, and by hosting negotiations, the Organization has become a mechanism for governments to find areas of agreement and solve problems together."

The IMF and the World Bank Group were established to manage the financial strategies as laid out in the Bretton Woods Agreement and the Marshall Plan. Conversely, the role of the United Nations is to facilitate the dialog relating to human rights and various socio-political issues of its member states.

The Asian Royal Families, whose SRP funded the International Treaties for the rebuilding of nations after World War II, decided in 2005 (after the treaties expired) not to renew their financial commitments to the IMF and the World Bank Group because these two organizations failed to achieve their respective goals and objectives. The evidence of such failure is the overwhelming debt position of every nation and the existence of nearly 3.6 billion people living in poverty today. Unfortunately, in order to continue their operations, the two organizations are funding themselves using an internal private placement-trading platform to generate capital.

The four principal treaties that were utilized by the said organizations as underwriting and financing tools to rebuild every nation are as follows:

1. **The Treaty of Versailles (1919):** underwritten by 1.5 Million Metric tonnes of Gold and funded on June 14, 1946;
2. **The Bilateral Minesfield Agreement (1950),** expired in 2000: underwritten by 1.5 Million Metric tonnes of Gold;
3. **The Trilateral Tripartite Agreement (1950),** expired in 2000: underwritten by 1.5 Million Metric tonnes of Gold; and

4. **The Green Hilton Agreement (1963)**, expired circa 2005: underwritten by 1.5 Million Metric tonnes of gold.

**A Different Approach**

GIDIFA, under my leadership, decided to take a different approach. It will directly enter into tailored sovereign treaties with every nation based on a collaborative model to stabilize the current economic and financial systems to ensure social and economic freedom.

As evidence of the fact that the undersigned Honorable Angel Ferdinand Marcos has the sole, lawful control and authority of the Sovereign Royal Portfolio, it is only necessary for someone with the proper security clearances and authorization to access the banking screens and follow the simple procedure outlined hereunder:

The above-stated Global Master Accounts against which the entire global monetary system is underwritten and financed, are held in secured facilities worldwide that I assigned to GIDIFA. The same absolutely remain under my code and control.

Additionally, in 2007 and again in 2012, over 400 world leaders signed the respective Committee of the 300 SRP account confirmation documents affirming the existence of the SRP.

For absolute financial confirmation of the SRP, I have included key portions of the statements and declarations made particularly in the 2007 document, confirming that the SRP contains thirteen million and four hundred and thirteen thousand and five hundred (13,413,500) metric tonnes of gold, monetized and leveraged for 70 years and converted into cash, with an aggregate sum as stated above. These documents contain a "**Cloak of Secrecy**" and "**Confidentiality Clause**" that bound each signatory to secrecy regarding the existence and content of the documents.

**Undisputable Facts and Implication**

1. In 2011, the US Treasury issued a series of International Bills of Exchange (IBOEs) equal to the total value of the SRP;
2. The IBOEs were officially registered under the Uniform Commercial Code (UCC) Law Filings; and
3. GIDIFA declared, registered and filed through the UCC filings, 263 underground bunkers, 172 underground vaults, 850 sites and 6,000 untouched bunkers.

The facts as noted above, show that the entire SRP was placed under the sole control and authority of the undersigned Honorable Angel Ferdinand Marcos.

**Epilogue**

The rules, protocols and procedures are clear and the Royal Sovereign Jurisdiction is absolute and binding with respect to the utilization of the SRP. Hence, only a sovereign treaty can be used as a binding document by and between GIDIFA and the United Nations and its member states to create this strategic alliance.

In view of all the foregoing, the strategic alliance and cooperative effort by and between GIDIFA and the United Nations and its member states is strongly hoped to directly address many of the issues facing the world today which are anchored on the following questions:

1. How do we reconcile the fact that every nation is currently in a state of bankruptcy?

3. Are we brave enough to face these challenges head on and choose a path of sustainable peace and prosperity?

The greatest sector of humanity is undoubtedly desirous to reclaim their natural rights and sovereign status, liberating themselves from all forms of slavery.
