TREATY AGREEMENT

The Terms and Conditions of this Treaty are the desires as have been set forth and established by and between Global Infrastructure, Development and International Finance Agency as represented by the Honorable Secretary General, Mr. Angel Ferdinand Marcos and Her Royal Highness, Princess Merriam T. Kiram representing the Sultanate of the Sulu Archipelago. This Treaty is a mutual Agreement and Pledge to the People of the Sultanate of the Sulu Archipelago, the Philippines and to the world so that the people of the world will be able to see the positive transformation and the increase in the median standard of living of the people when Sovereign Bodies work with and for the people directly. This Pledge is undertaken and given with recognition of the fact that it is only possible with the complete and total cooperation of the Sovereign Bodies whose signatures affirm and testify to the veracity of this Treaty and who have sworn to fulfill their obligations not to each other, but to the People of the World under the Terms and Conditions such as set forth herein and as may be decided by and between The Interested Parties as these Terms and Conditions are met and fulfilled.

- 1 The Interested Parties affirm and attest that their efforts shall all provide direct support, guidance, comfort and/or assistance to the Underclass Members of the society in which such Humanitarian Projects shall be pursued.
- 2 Global Infrastructure, Development and International Finance Agency has pledged an amount of One Trillion US Dollars (US \$1,000,000,000,000.00) in the form of a Gold-Backed International Bill of Exchange (or IBOE See Attached) for the pursuit of Humanitarian Projects in and around the Sultanate of the Sulu Archipelago.
- 3 The Interested Parties affirm and attest that they shall, together, provide for any and all such costs as may be related to the Monetization of the IBOE.
- 4 Global Infrastructure, Development and International Finance Agency has pledged to begin the release of funds within Seventy-Two International Banking Hours of the successful Monetization of the IBOE for the purposes of the commencement of Humanitarian Projects and Programs within and around the Sultanate of the Sulu Archipelago.
- 5 Global Infrastructure, Development and International Finance Agency has pledged to trade one-half of the Face Value of the IBOE for the purposes of expanding the ability of The Interested Parties to Plan and Implement additional Humanitarian Programs in and around the Sultanate of the Sulu Archipelago.

6 **The Interested Parties** have agreed to work together in a Joint Forces Agreement to provide for the successful planning, implementation, management and completion of the Humanitarian Projects as may be undertaken for the people in and around the Sultanate of the Sulu Archipelago.





- 7 The Interested Parties affirm and attest that a minimum of One Thousand (1000) projects shall be planned and applied in the first phase of the implementation of this treaty.
- 8 The Interested Parties have discussed, acknowledged and agreed that One Percent (1%) of the Net Income of the Sovereign Body shall be divided equally among the people of the Sultanate of the Sulu Archipelago
- 9 The Interested Parties have discussed, acknowledged and agreed that the Humanitarian Projects to be pursued for the people in and around the Sultanate of the Sulu Archipelago shall include but shall not necessarily be limited to the following Joint Ventures and/or Joint Forces Projects.
 - 9.1 The provision of safe and secure housing for the people
 - 9.2 The provision of safe and secure Physical Infrastructural Development to include homes, shelters, and any and all other such buildings as shall be constructed under the finances and terms of this Treaty Agreements

- 9.2.11.1 The Interested Parties Agree that any and all such Commercial and Industrial Pursuits shall include the provision of jobs for the local populace in accordance with standards such as shall be deemed to be prudent and/or beneficial in the Implementation of the Terms and Conditions of this Treaty
- 9.3 The Provision of basic and/or advanced Infrastructural Services necessary for the people in and around the Sulu Archipelago to survive and thrive including but not limited to the provision of the following (Programs to be subsidized and paid for in part and/or in whole through the trade of the Initial Investment amounts)
 - 9.3.1 Free and/or Reduced Cost Emergency and Long-Term Healthcare
 - 9.3.2 Free and/or Reduced Cost Education from pre-schooling to post-graduate courses
 - 9.3.3 Food Provision for the Underclass
 - 9.3.4 Sociological Assistance for the purposes of providing people with the necessary knowledge and skills to improve their life and lifestyle
 - 9.3.4.1 The Establishment of a Public Forum to give a direct voice to the people for the purposes of assisting The Interested Parties in the selection and implementation of future Projects, Programs and Phases

- 9.9 Such Commercial and Industrial Ventures as shall be deemed to be prudent and/or necessary for the Successful implementation of the Terms and Conditions of this treaty
- 9.10 Training for and implementation of programs with a focus on Sustainability
- 10 Social Programs to promote social health, welfare and order to include but not to be limited to the following
 - 10.1 Increased Police Protection including additional funding for local police, police equipment and other such materials as may be deemed to be prudent and/or necessary


